

## **VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION INITIAL EVALUATION**

The following codes are to be used for charging for vocational Evaluation and Management services. These services are defined in detail below.

## XV001 Limited Initial Vocational Evaluation

Key Factors:

- Review of injured workers' medical records
- Scheduling of injured workers' initial evaluation with the vocational rehabilitation counselor
- Face to face initial vocational interview
- Initial vocational rehabilitation report with recommendations based upon hierarchy of vocational rehabilitation

Contributory items would include:

- Injured worker has limited work history
- Clearly defined transferable skills
- Physical restrictions defined by medical providers are of low severity

## XV002 Expanded Initial Vocational Evaluation

- Review of injured workers' medical records
- Scheduling of injured workers' initial evaluation with the vocational rehabilitation counselor
- Face to face initial vocational interview
- Transferable skills analysis completed
- Initial vocational rehabilitation report with recommendations based upon hierarchy of vocational rehabilitation

Contributory items would include:

- Injured worker has a moderate work history
- Minimally defined transferable skills
- Physical restrictions defined by medical providers are moderate

## **XV003** Comprehensive Initial Evaluation

- Review of injured workers' medical records
- Scheduling of injured workers' initial evaluation with the vocational rehabilitation counselor
- Extended initial vocational interview
- Transferable skills analysis completed
- Initial vocational rehabilitation report with recommendations based upon hierarchy of vocational rehabilitation

Contributory items would include:

- Injured worker has a complex work history
- No clearly defined transferable skills
- Physical restrictions defined by medical providers are complex
